






Tips & Tricks for Early Literacy @ Home

Doing hands-on activities related to a book or story helps kids get interested in books, and make connections with what they learned in the story









Coloring Station

Instructions:


Color in Pete and his shoes using crayons or markers.



Blocks Station


Prompt: What does Pete **step in** next?

What **gets on** Pete's shoes next?




Instructions:


- 1.**Choose** 5 or more pieces of torn paper from the bin

- 6.**Repeat** until Pete's shoes are covered





